Make clear links between the story of the Good Samaritan and the idea of the Gospel as 'good news'.

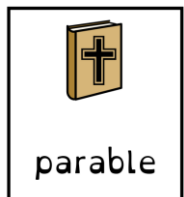
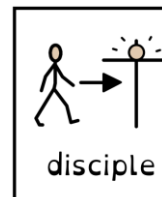
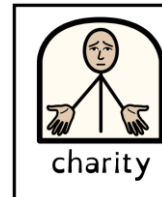
Offer some ideas about the meaning of the Good Samaritan story to Christians.
