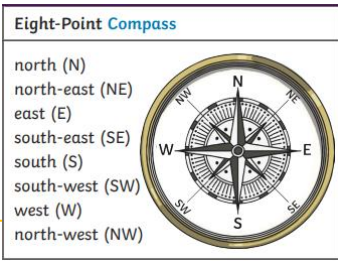


Expanding Faversham
