What should I already know?

**phonics**

**accents** Accents indicate the vowel is stressed. As seen in the words *sábado* and *miércoles*.

**ñ tilde** This changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound like in the English word 'onion'. As in the Spanish word *cumpleaños*.

**grammar**

Days of the week and months of the year do not have capital letters unless they are at the start of a sentence in Spanish.

**Hoy es lunes ocho de julio.**

Today it is Monday eighth July.

No capital letter in the phrase above for the day of the week 'Monday' or the month 'July' in Spanish.
