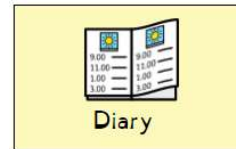
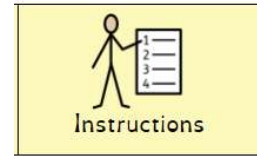
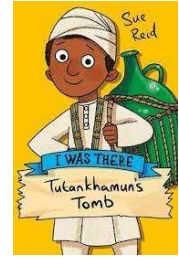
- Draw inferences and justify with evidence e.g. characters' feelings, thoughts and motives, from their actions or
