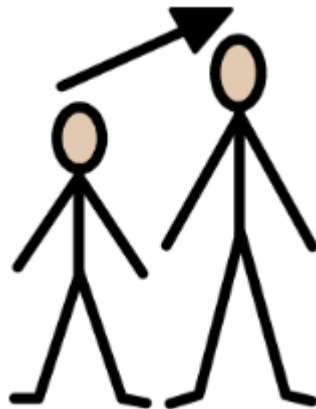


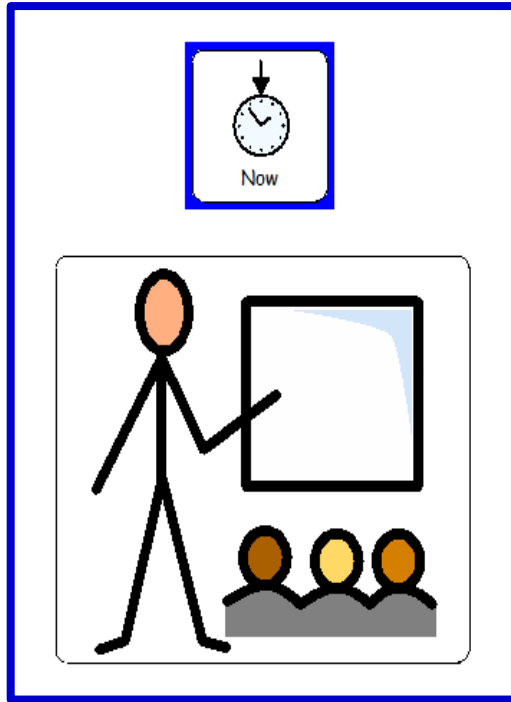


I am growing bigger and getting

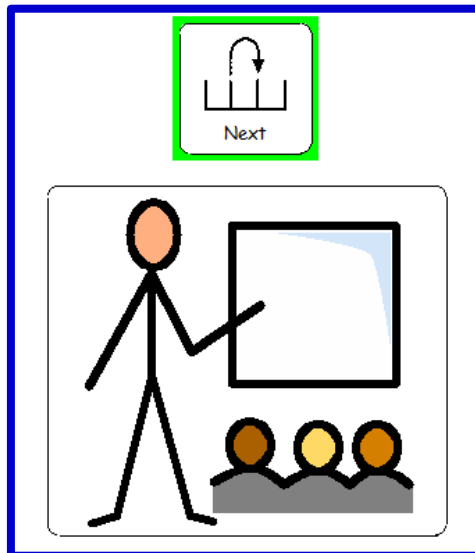
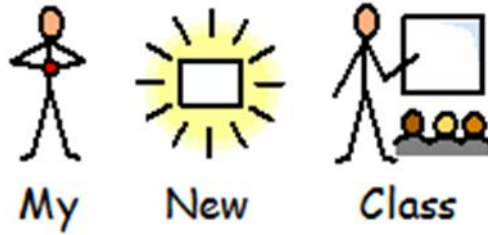
In September, I will move to a

Now, I am in Year 2.



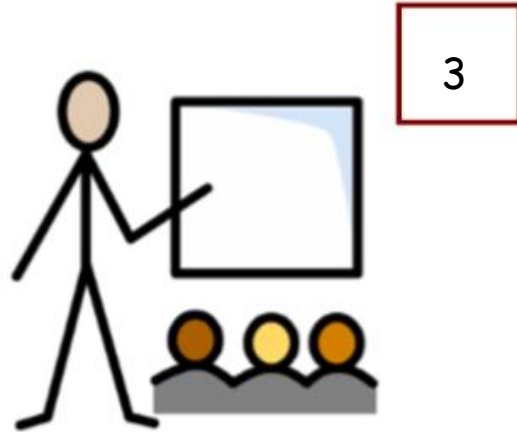


After the long summer holidays,

My new teacher will help me to learn and will keep me safe.

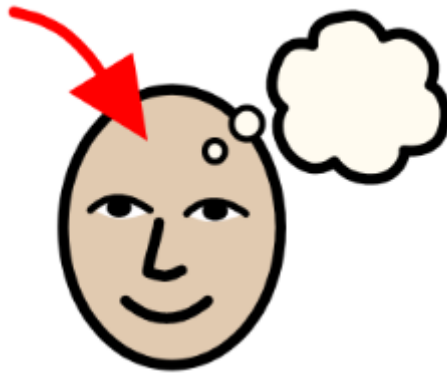
I might feel worried about moving

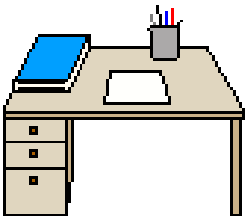
This is my new classroom. This is

and my belongings.

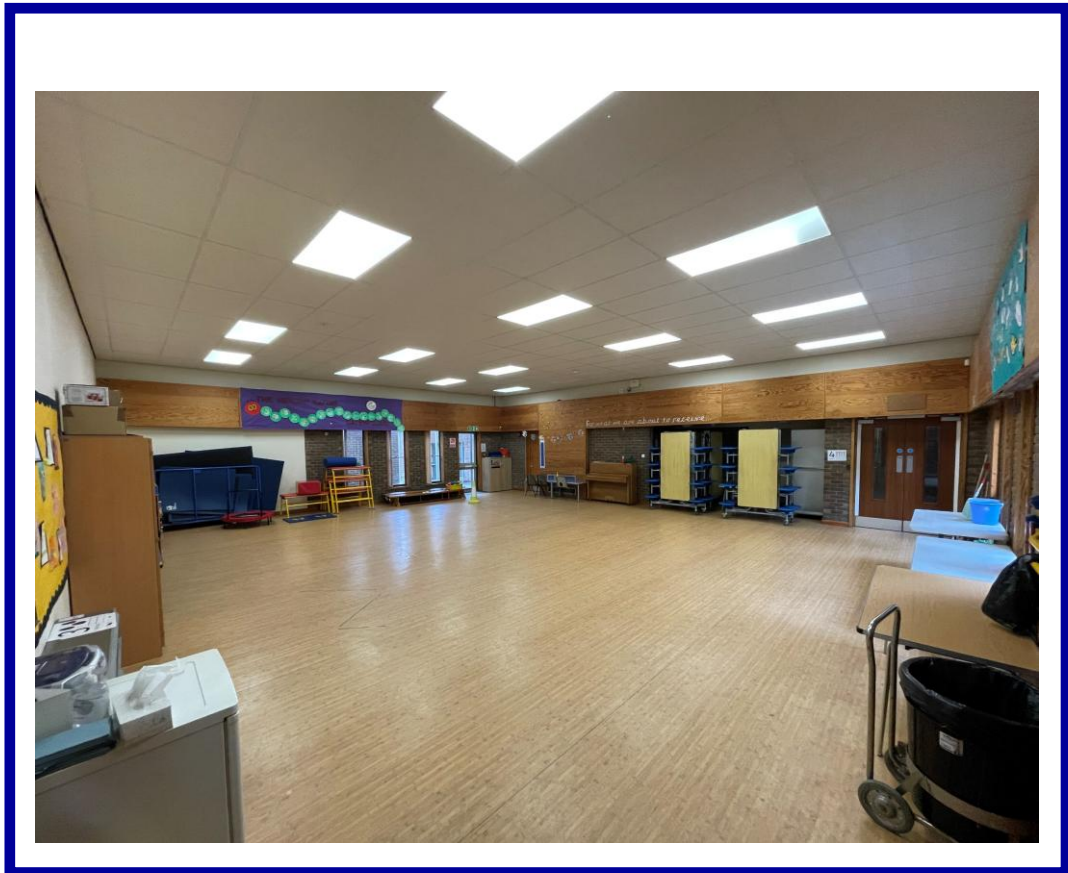
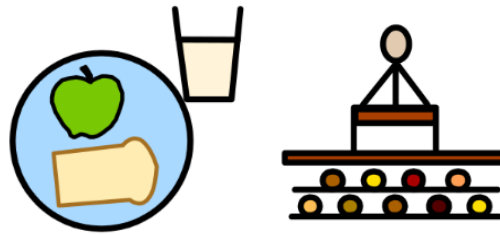


This is what a desk will look like. I
will do my work here.



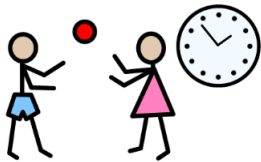
This is the KS1 hall.

of activities in here.

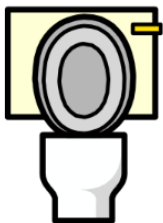


This is the playground. I will come here at playtime.

These are the toilets I will use.

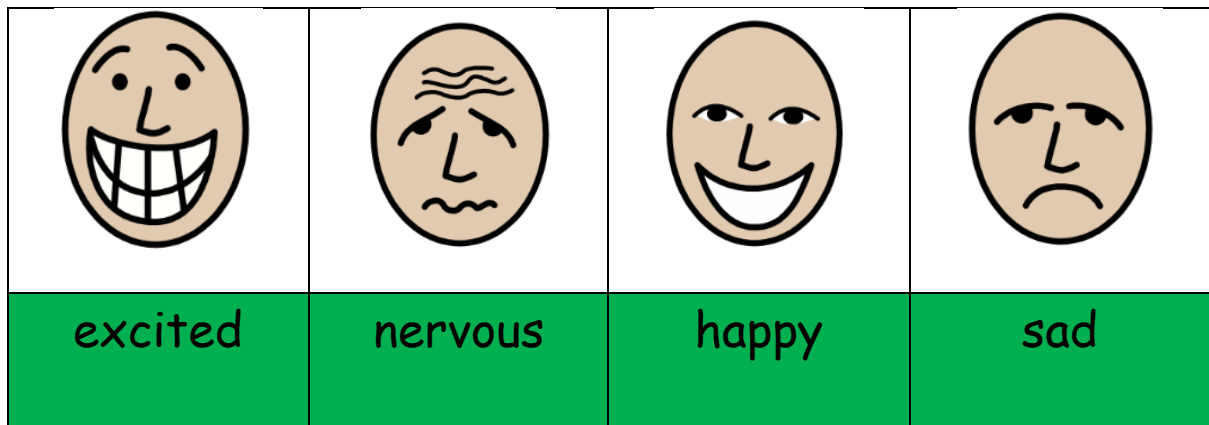


TOP TIP: If I need to go to the toilet I need to ask one of the adults in the room.

me feel:



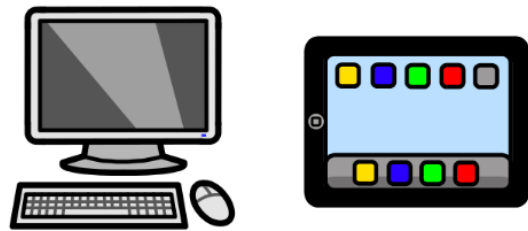
